**Trustees' Annual Report and Accounts 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019**

- We have held a religious service every weekend either on Friday evening or Saturday (Shabbat) morning.
- Our Rabbi (Mark Solomon) visits at least monthly when he takes services and leads educational activities. At other times members of the community lead the services.
- We hold services for all the Jewish Festivals, including the High Holydays (Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur) and we run a Communal Seder (Passover meal) which is well attended by members and visitors.
- Adult education classes have included exploring Judaism, a Talmud study group, and a philosophy discussion group.
- During this year we have held almost all of our services to St Mark's Unitarian church in Castle Terrace, Edinburgh, except for our shorter Kabbalat Shabbat services that continue to be held in the community rooms of Marchmont St Giles Church Centre.
- Our Cheder (religion school) meets on alternate Saturday afternoons during school term time and has an expanding recruitment.
- Rabbi Mark Solomon continues to support us and be an inspiration to us, both at his regular visits but also with advice and support at other times.
- Most of our communication with members and others is via emails and by information on our web site ([www.eljc.org](http://www.eljc.org)).
